## D-River Dredging Project

Devils Lake Water Improvement District is working with a civil engineer and environmental firm to create plans to dredge the western point of Devils Lake and D-River. The goal is to remove up to 2,000 cubic yards of accumulated sand and debris from this area to help improve summer flow and reduce high water and flooding in the winter. King Tides have pushed sand and debris up the channel where it settles. The last time this was address was 2004 and is due for maintenance.
